

## **Lifespan Learning Committee (Replaces Adult Education Committee)**

The purpose of the Lifespan Learning Committee is:

- To provide educational and spiritual opportunities for adult members and friends in subject areas that are connected to our Unitarian Universalist values and principles.

To accomplish this purpose the Lifespan Learning Committee shall:

- Be formed as a committee, with a chairperson and multiple committee members.
- Provide information on programming to the Chirp, Order of Service and to the Marketing Committee in order to publicize and encourage participation.
- Meet semi-annually and as needed.
- Prepare and present a proposed budget to the Finance Committee for approval each fiscal year.
- Prepare and present a written report to the congregation.

The Lifespan Learning Committee will perform the following functions for the adult members and friends of the congregation:

- Receive interests of adult members and friends as to topics where special educational or spiritual programs would serve their needs or wants.
- Organize and implement special programs to address specific educational or spiritual needs or wants that have been identified.
- Work with the Minister to identify educational and spiritual needs and wants and to develop programs.
- Maintain contacts with the Sunday Service Committee and the DREAM Team and coordinate activities with such committees where their activities have relevance to the adult educational or spiritual topics and possible programs.
