

Nominating Committee

Purpose: To nominate officers and trustees of the church.

To accomplish this purpose, the Nominating Committee shall:

- Consist of three members: the outgoing President of the Board of Trustees, and two members whose terms are two years each, to be elected in alternate years, plus one alternate for a term of one year. This recommended slate shall be stated in the notice of such meeting.
- Notify the voting members of the church of its nominations for officers and trustees at least ten days before the Annual Meeting by listing such nominations in the notice of the Annual Meeting.

Further regulations:

- Any voting member shall be entitled to nominate a candidate or candidate(s) for any office from the floor at any meeting at which officers, Trustees, or members of the Nominating Committee are elected.
- All members of the Nominating Committee must be voting members of the Church.
