

Social Committee

The purpose of the Social Committee is:

- To serve the social needs of the First Unitarian Church by being aware of, initiating, and planning and coordinating social activities for all ages, in and for the Church.

To accomplish this purpose the Social Committee shall:

- Be formed as a committee, with a chairperson and multiple committee members.
- Hold meetings when necessary for planning specific events.
- Prepare and present a proposed budget to the Finance Committee for approval each fiscal year.
- Prepare and present a written annual report to the congregation.

The Social Committee will perform the following functions to help the congregation socialize:

- Coordinate Church social activities, such as:
 - Coffee Hour
 - Monthly Potlucks
 - Feasters
 - Women's Potlucks
 - Christmas Eve reception
 - Church anniversary receptions
 - Pancake Breakfast
- Assist with memorial services for friends and members, including:
 - Finding volunteers to provide finger foods
 - Making and serving coffee
 - Setup and cleanup
- Assist with the social aspects of the annual pledge drive and other special events specified by the Board.
