

DREAM (Directors of Religious Education and Mindfulness) Team (replaces Religious Education Committee)

The purpose of the DREAM Team is:

To provide religious education for children and youth (ages 0-18). Religious Education here is defined as learning where we come from, how to live an interconnected life, and how to figure out where we are going. We do this through the exploration of themes such as Unitarian Universalist identity and values, world religions, the web of life, how to treat others, and social justice.

To accomplish this purpose the DREAM Team shall:

- Be formed as a committee, with multiple team members.
- Hold regularly scheduled meetings.
- Prepare and present a proposed budget to the Finance Committee for approval each fiscal year.
- Prepare and present a written annual report to the congregation.

DREAM Team will perform the following functions for the membership of the congregation:

- Collaborate with the Director/Coordinator of Religious Education.
- Select curriculum for Sunday school classes.
- Recruit and train RE teachers.
- Plan and carry out RE teacher recognition program.
- Assist Sunday Service Committee and minister in planning intergenerational services.
- Provide child care/nursery program for Sunday morning services.
- Provide representation to the Director/Coordinator of Religious Education search committee.

In the absence of a Director/Coordinator of Religious Education, the DREAM Team will take on those responsibilities for the week-to-week operation of the RE classes.
