

Peace and Social Justice Committee

The purpose of the Peace and Social Justice Committee is:

- To work for peace and social justice within the church congregation, the local community, the state, the nation, and internationally.

To accomplish this purpose the Peace and Social Justice Committee shall:

- Be formed as a committee with a chairperson and multiple committee members.
- Hold regularly scheduled meetings of the committee.
- Prepare and present a proposed budget to the Financial Committee for approval each fiscal year.
- Prepare and present a written annual report to the congregation.

The Peace and Social Justice Committee shall perform the following functions for the congregation:

- Inform the congregation of issues of peace and social justice through written materials, speakers, videos, discussions, etc.
- Involve the congregation in efforts to secure peace and social justice.
- Represent the church in local community peace and social justice issues and efforts.
- Collect suggestions for an all-church peace and social justice service project and present them at the annual congregation meeting.
- Recommend for Board of Trustees approval occasional fund raisers for special peace and social justice projects.
